Financial Aid Provided by former MDHS Letter Winners

Annually, the Mater Dei Lettermen's Club awards financial aid to qualifying student-athletes. This program is in addition to other Mater Dei financial aid programs.

To be eligible for this source of financial aid, the applicant must have qualified for financial aid through the Mater Dei business office for the 2009-2010 school year. Returning students must have maintained a minimum of a 2.0 GPA during the 2008-2009 academic year and not been on disciplinary probation during that year. The applicant must be a participant in one or more of Mater Dei's CIF sanctioned sports programs during the 2008-2009 academic year and, very importantly, the athlete must exhibit the true "Monarch Spirit".

Applications will be available in the Alumni Office on February 6, 2009 or on the Mater Dei website at www.materdei.org (Under the Alumni Information section). The deadline for the MD Lettermen's Club Financial Aid Application is Friday, May 8, 2009 by 5:00 p.m.

To be eligible for a Lettermen's Club Grant, the applicant must have qualified for financial aid through the Mater Dei business office for the 2009-2010 school year; participated successfully in a Mater Dei Sports program in the 2008-2009 school year; must have maintained a minimum 2.0 GPA during the 2008-2009 school year and cannot have been on disciplinary probation during the 2008-09 school year. Students will be notified by mail by the end of June if awarded a grant.
