I am pleased to announce that for the 2012 season we have reduced our fees. Varsity is now \$1,100 and Junior Varsity, Frosh/Soph Red and Grey are now \$850. Due to the cost of production of the media guides and electronic displays it has become necessary to make a change to our sponsorship sales. This year 75% of your sponsorship sales will go towards your season's overall fee. Also, the girls will be permitted to keep their entire gear package; no need to return anything at the end of the season.

#### Freshman Player and Parent Meeting -

This season we are making it mandatory that every freshman player along with their parents schedule a meeting with our Varsity Head Coach and Program Director Adam Cutrell. Coach Cutrell wants to get to know all of you so that we can better suit your needs as well as answer any questions that you may have. Meetings can be scheduled through Coach Cutrell as the season moves forward.

#### <u>2012Team Fees –</u>

Team fees for 2012have decreased! They are \$1100 for Varsity, and \$850 for the JV and Freshmen teams.

Fees are due by the first day of school, August 27, 2012. If extra time is needed, payments may be spread out over September; however,1) a minimum of \$600 per playermust be paid by August 27,2)an extended payment plan must be pre-arranged with Head Coach Adam Cutrell, and 3) all fees must be paid in full by October 1. If help is needed to pay for a player's fees, please see the "Sponsorships" section below.

#### Sponsorships—

Sponsors provide financial support for the Mater Dei Girls' Volleyball program. Sponsorships may be purchased by a player's family, or sold to friends, neighbors and businesses to help pay for someof a players team fees for 2012. #### Picture Day -

Lower level team and individual pictures will be Monday, August 13 at 10:00am. Varsity will be scheduled for a later time once everyone is back from vacations. Payment is due on picture day. Pictures are optional and will also be made available online.

#### <u>Durango Fall Classic –</u>

The Varsity squad will be traveling to Las Vegas to compete in the Durango Fall Classic volleyball tournament on September 14-16. The team will be driving in the Mater Dei vans and staying at the Westgate Resort. Details are still being finalized, but the cost is not expected to exceed \$250 per player.

#### Snack Bar -

We will again be hosting a snack bar during all home volleyball games. Parents will be assigned dates and times to work the snack bar and will be responsible for trading their shift with another parent if they cannot make their assigned time slot. Parents will also be asked to volunteer to bring various homemade items during the season to sell at the snack bar such as pasta salad, cookies, brownies, etc. Each player is required to contribute to the snack bar beverage supply as follows:

Freshmen & JV Squads – 1large case (24 bottles) EACH of assorted Gatorades

and bottled water (2 cases total)

Varsity – 2 cases (24 cans each) soda (Coke/diet, Pepsi, Sprite, root beer)

Beverage contributions will be collected **during the week of August 20** and are to be turned in ONLY to a player's coach so that it can be logged in and credit given to the player. In addition to working the snack bar, parents will be assigned to work the admissions table athome games. Parents are not assigned to work during a game in which their daughter's team is playing; however they will be responsible for trading their shift with another parent if they cannot make their assigned time slot.



# Mater Dei High School Daktronics Video Boards – Specifications


### Board #1 – East End Wall Prostar Display



This board is a full video LED display. Graphics can be created at 72 dpi at 240 pixels wide by 176 pixels tall. Graphics must be submitted in the bitmap (.bmp) format. If you need a size template, we have them for Microsoft Publisher software.




## Board #2 – West End Wall Prostar Display



This board is also a full video LED display, with graphics that can be created at 72 dpi at 240 pixels wide by 176 pixels tall. Graphics must be submitted in the bitmap (.bmp) format, same as Board #1.

There are two video units that make up this board system. Each of the smaller units is 176 pixels wide by 48 pixels tall. We combine the two sister units to broadcast a graphic of 352 pixels wide by 48 pixels tall over the two tables. # Mater Dei Girls' Volleyball Sponsorships, the Fall Media Guide, and Electronic Displays

### **FAQ**

- 1. What is a "sponsorship?" Sponsorship is a way of supporting the Mater Dei girls' volleyball program. Selling sponsorships is a means for a player to help pay for some or all of her annual team fees. Every dollar a player sells in sponsorships results in a dollar-for-dollar reduction in team fees owed.
- 2. Who are our sponsors, what do they do, and what do they receive? Sponsors provide financial support for the Mater Dei Girls' Volleyball program and can be parents, grandparents, friends, neighbors, local businesses, etc. They help support the Mater Dei Girls' volleyball team and, in turn, receive space for a personal tribute or business recognition in either the Fall Media Guide or on the Electronic Display panels in the Meruelo Athletic Center at Mater Dei during all home games.
- 3. What if I don't want or need to sell sponsorships? If a player's parents choose to fully pay her fees without selling outside sponsorships, the parents are considered sponsors and will still receive sponsorship space for one personal tribute either in the printed Media Guide (payment required by August 29) or on the electronic display boards in the gym (payment by October 1). Varsity players will receive a full page in the Media Guide and players on the JV and freshmen squads will receive a half page, provided the print deadline of August 29 is met; if not, they will receive a full digital display. A sponsorship form should still be submitted for parent sponsors.
- 4. What is the "Fall Media Guide?" The Fall Media Guide is a glossy 8 ½" x 11" saddle stitched book in both color and black and white. It features information about both the school and the girls' volleyball program, including coach and player bios, team photos and schedules, personal tributes, and many, many business sponsorships. Media Guides are sold at all home volleyball matches and are also available to younger students who are considering Mater Dei for high school and attend one of Mater Dei's information nights. A Media Guide will also be provided to each player and outside sponsor by September 16, 2012.
- 5. What is an "Electronic Display?" In the Meruelo Athletic Center, we are fortunate to have multiple large digital display panels on the floor level scorers Pro-Table panels (18' total panel length) and on two 9' x 8' big screen video scoreboards. These spaces can be used for either personal messages or business name recognition. The full color displays are featured at 6-8 second intervals on a continuous loop during all home matches.
- 6. **How much does it cost to be a sponsor?** Sponsorships in the Fall Media Guide range from \$100 for a business card up to \$1500 for the full-color middle spread of the program. The Electronic Display sponsorships are \$300 for recognition on all digital boards in the Athletic Center during all games. Please see separate "Fall 2012 Annual Sponsorship Form" for further details.
- 7. **When can I sell sponsorships?** Sponsorships in the Media Guide can be sold any time between now and the start of school. For these print sponsorships, all forms, payment and graphics must be received no later than August 29, 2012. Electronic display sponsorships may be sold and submitted up until October 1, 2012.
- 8. What if I need help putting together a personal tribute or recognizing a business sponsor? Email Joanne Shebby at jshebby@hotmail.com with any questions, pictures, wording ideas, etc, and we will work with you. If you need assistance with layout, please allow several days extra before the entry deadlines mentioned above August 29 for print and October 1 for digital.
- 9. **How do the print tributes and the digital displays differ?** The Media Guide allows for more detail and information due to the nature of the graphics and the printing process. The digital displays need to be simpler and shorter one picture and a few lines max but they run in a continuous loop at 6-8 second intervals.
- 10. What if a restaurant wants to be a sponsor and provide food in lieu of payment? Although we have occasionally accepted this type of sponsorship in the past, we don't anticipate accepting any new restaurant sponsors this year because a vendor must be on Mater Dei's list of pre-approved suppliers, and this application process takes approximately 4 months to complete.
