# CIF-SS-FORD SWIMMING & DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS MOVE TO RCC

The CIF Southern Section-Ford Swimming and Diving Championships will have a new home and format this spring as the Riverside Aquatics Complex on the campus of Riverside Community College will serve as the new host.

The facility completed a recent renovation project on campus and a joint project with the city of Riverside. It is one of the most state of the art facilities in the country. A 65 meter facility, Riverside boasts an Olympic style venue complete with an Olympic dive tower and 2 additional 25 yard pools on site.

Additionally, given the ability to host swimming and diving in one location, the CIF-SS has amended the format of the meet. With the ability to accommodate more qualifiers and finalists, the meet will now accept 36 qualifiers into the preliminary events with the top 20 returning for consolation and final heats (10 in each). Points will be awarded for the top 20 swimmers and divers (top 8 will receive medals). Diving "finals" (last three rounds of diving) will be incorporated into the swimming event line up in finals. The format of Championship Finals will be the following:

200 Medley Relay

200 Free

200 IM

50 Freestyle

Girls' Diving Finals Rounds 9-11 (3 dives for the finalists; approx. 30 min.)

100 Butterfly

100 Freestyle

500 Freestyle

200 Freestyle Relay

Boys' Diving Finals: Rounds 9-11 (3 dives for the finalists: approx. 30 min.)

100 Backstroke

100 Breaststroke

400 Freestyle RelaY

The finals 3 rounds of diving will be completed during the Swimming Finals for that specific division.

"I am pleased and excited to announce this new venue," stated Assistant Commissioner in charge of aquatics Kristine Palle. "This complex is state of the art and with the ability to host diving at the same facility it really gives us a chance to provide greater athlete participation and fan excitement".

For 31 of the past 42 years Belmont Plaza Olympic Pool has served as host of the CIF Southern Section Boys/Girls Swimming Championships. The only exceptions were in 1975-78 and 1980-86 when East Los Angeles College played host. Also, in 2009, Mt. San Antonio College in Walnut served in that capacity at the last minute when Belmont suffered a fire just prior to the event.

"We will miss the history and tradition of Belmont Plaza," added Palle. "It has been a world class venue for many years and has hosted some the greatest swimmers in history. We will truly miss and want to thank the amazing staff at the facility who have treated us like family for so many years."
